Neighborhood Reward Program

Since January 29, 2007, St. Louis Catholic School has earned a total of \$61,557.25 from the **Kroger Neighborhood Reward Card Program**. In any given month, 140 cards are used. Last year we averaged about \$1,950 per month during the school year, but it drops off during the summer. Please remember to use your cards...*it's free money for SLS.*

Don't have a **Kroger Neighborhood Reward Gift Card** from St. Louis School? It is easy! Here is how it works....

- Purchase your Kroger Gift Card from the SLS Office for \$2.00. The \$2.00 will be applied to your balance. Keep the card to reload
- When you shop at Kroger, before paying for your purchases, reload your Kroger Gift Card with the cashier or at the service desk for any amount up to \$250.00
- You may load your Kroger Gift Card by cash, credit card or check. When you reload your card, St. Louis School earns money. Your gift card must maintain a minimum of \$1.00 balance. A gift card with a zero balance for 90 days will become inactive and a new Kroger Gift Card will need to be purchased
- The more you shop, the more you earn for St. Louis School. SLS will receive a rebate check for 4% of the earnings over \$5,000 at the end of a 4-week cycle
- You can purchase any merchandise in a Kroger store, as well as the Kroger Pharmacy or gas station with the Kroger Gift Card
